SPEAKER SERIES MARCH 8th, 2018 *Small Farm Growing in Home Gardens*

Tony Bracco of Bracco Farms in Pine Island NY will explain how to adapt best-practices small-farm gardening techniques to our own home gardens using organic non-GMO farming disciplines. Tony will share with us tips on “how its done” at Bracco Farms. Bracco Farms came into being in 2009, born out of a passion for high-quality fresh vegetables and fruit. Located just north of the NJ border in the heart of Orange County, this “Black Dirt Region” is a remnant of the Ice Age in which thick deposits of nutrient-rich topsoil (from 30% to 90% organic matter) were left behind by retreating glaciers.
